

Heritage High School Digital Learning Responsibility Agreement

Please note that students who cannot bring outside technology will be able to access and utilize the school's equipment. No student will be left out of instructional activities. The Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) initiative helps curb costs incurred by schools while allowing students to utilize technology as a valuable learning tool.

In addition to adhering to the code of student conduct and school policies regarding Internet Acceptability Use and Internet Safety Policies, students must follow the guidelines for BYOD Acceptable Use outlined below.

- Students may only have mobile devices on and visible upon the teacher's request. Students must comply with teacher's requests to turn off mobile devices when asked to do so.
- Students must utilize WCPSS Wi-Fi while on campus to ensure proper filters and protections are in place.
- Students realize that processing or accessing information on school property related to "hacking", altering, or bypassing network security policies is in violation of the AUP policy and will result in disciplinary actions.
- Students must only use mobile devices to complete activities directly pertaining to the lesson.
- Students may not use their mobile devices for personal communication during school hours.
- The device may not be used to cheat on assignments or tests, or for non-instructional purposes.
- Cell phone ringers must be set to silent while on campus.
- Students are prohibited from copying or posting pictures, video or sound clips on any social media (including, but not limited to Facebook, MySpace, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, Vine, Snapchat, etc.).
- The school district has the right to collect and examine any device that is suspected as the source for online bullying/harassment, or the origin of inappropriate material suspected as the source of a virus infection.

Students violating this agreement will be subject to consequences and to losing the privilege of participating in BYOD.

- Neither teachers nor the school technology department will provide technical support for mobile devices.
- The school may not be held liable for the actions of anyone connected to the Internet through the school's Wi-Fi access.
- Students are responsible for damage or loss of their personal mobile devices.
- Printing from a mobile device is not possible from this campus.
